
TANZ eCampus Learner Rights and Responsibilities

TANZ eCampus is concerned about the welfare and achievement of ALL its learners. To create and maintain the best possible teaching and learning environment, all learners registered with/using services of TANZ eCampus are expected to accept certain responsibilities, respect the rights of others and behave in an acceptable manner.

Your Rights as a Registered Learner

Fairness

- open and accurate information
- fair evaluation and assessment
- problems handled as quickly as practicable and consistent with 'natural justice'
- personal privacy

Respect

- freedom from any form of harassment or unjust discrimination
- respect for personal, social and cultural differences

Standards

- programmes that meet internal and external standards for approval and registration
- competent and effective teaching
- appropriate support services, delivered in a professional manner

Your Responsibilities as a Learner

Behave safely

- take precautions so as not to endanger yourself or others

Respect others

- be sensitive to personal, social and cultural differences
- respect the needs, rights, and freedoms of others
- help to uphold the integrity of TANZ eCampus by discouraging/reporting dishonest practices.

Observe TANZ eCampus rules

- behave appropriately for a tertiary education environment
- endeavour to meet all course requirements
- be honest when completing assignments/other assessments
- follow TANZ eCampus and your enrolling ITP policies and regulations

Feedback for Success

We will provide some information to you during the course on your engagement and progress through the course. This information will be made available to you, and will also be made available to your advisor and facilitator to help you succeed. The information will include such things as your interaction with the website (when you log in, what activities you undertake, your progress and assessments) and link this to your progress through the course. From this, your facilitator and advisor can proactively provide appropriate support to

facilitate your success, and you can also proactively manage and optimize your learning for success. This data linked to your name will remain confidential to you, TANZ eCampus staff and relevant staff of your enrolling ITP. Any further dissemination of this data will be anonymized and at a group level (eg for everyone in a course).

We will also be seeking feedback during and at the end of the pilot from you about both the course material and delivery as well as the online environment. This data will be anonymous.

All data and feedback will be grouped and analysed and used to improve the service. Any reporting of analysed data will be anonymous.

Unacceptable Behaviour for Learners

Your responsibilities as a learner include behaving in an acceptable manner. The following are not acceptable behaviours:

- breaking any NZ law
- any form of cheating (including plagiarism and other dishonest practices)
- misuse of technology, software, hardware, or communication systems provided by TANZ eCampus
- infringement of copyright (including plagiarism) or software license agreements
- any form of harassment or discrimination

TANZ eCampus takes this statement of rights and responsibilities seriously. Infringement may be reported to your enrolling Institution to be dealt with under the relevant Institutional policy.
