

# HOKO PORTFOLIO DASHBOARD

Educators can use the Hoko Portfolio Dashboard to audit their digital resources and evaluate their readiness for online learning.

As a management tool, the Portfolio Dashboard allows organisations to review their own preparedness for online provision at a course level. The current online infrastructure of each course is evaluated and placed into one of four Internet Learning Indicator categories:

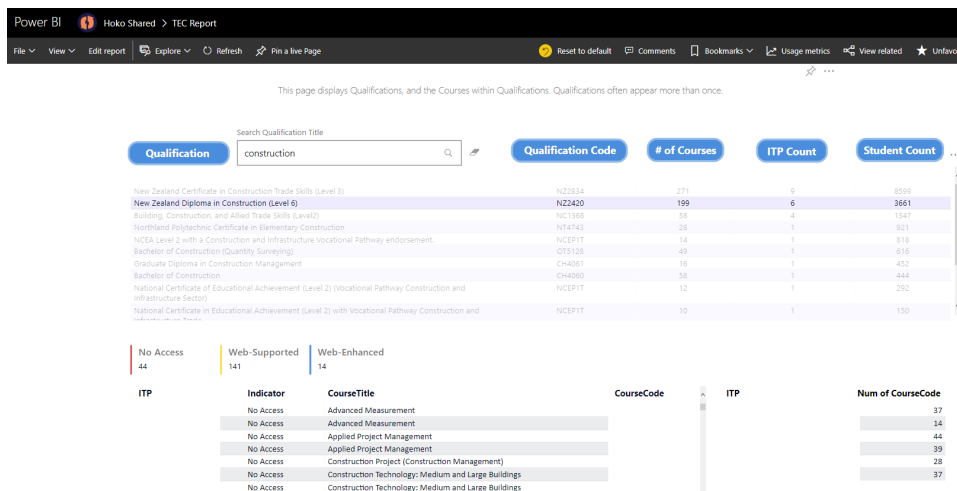


**No Access:** A course has no internet-based infrastructure to support learning.

**Web-supported:** A course is supported by an internet-based infrastructure, but there is no requirement for learners to engage in that infrastructure to successfully complete the course.

**Web-enhanced:** A course has an internet-based infrastructure and there is a requirement for learners actively engage in learning through that infrastructure to successfully complete the course.

**Web-based:** A course is fully delivered through an internet-based infrastructure.



This data can be compared with information submitted by similar organisations, providing opportunities for collaboration and resource-sharing. The tool can help organisations to identify necessary focus areas, using information such as learner group size and the degree of current course online provision.
